Successful SMRE Workshops 2016

The SMRE project and in particular its web-application supports and fosters a new broad joint research effort of doing crowd research on an international scale. Elaborating a web-application like the SMRE leads to many questions and challenges. In order to address these questions and challenges the SMRE-team has already organized two workshops in 2016: The first was in March on «Debating the Religious Composition of Europe: Religious Statistics, Methodology and Algorithms», the second followed in June on «The Output Tool of the SMRE. Function, Design, Possibilities of Analysis».

Output Tool is coming soon

The SMRE has been set up to improve the data situation on the religious composition of Europe. It will provide detailed statistics and consolidated «best data» on religious affiliation for European countries and regions including the EU. For this purpose we have set up a newly designed, interactive web-application. Its data entry tool is already online. The output tool will follow soon.
